ANIMAL ABANDONMENT IS ILLEGAL

Section 531-402 of the Revised Code of the consolidated City-County entitled, "Abandonment of animal," states, "*It shall be unlawful for a person to abandon any animal on public or private property in the city.*" **Violators** of section 531-402 **may be fined up to \$2,500 FOR EACH VIOLATION** (per section 103-3.)

IndyFeral Inc. is offering a **REWARD** for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the ABANDONMENT OF ANIMALS in this neighborhood.

To STOP THIS ILLEGAL ACT and apply for the reward, do the following now:

1. Immediately contact Indianapolis Animal Care and Control Division via the Mayor's Action Center at 317-327-4622. Give them the details of the situation and address where the crime is occurring and the name(s) of anyone committing the crime, if known.
2. Contact IndyFeral Inc. at 317-596-2300. Leave your name & phone number and the details of the situation, including the address where the crime is occurring, and the name(s) of anyone committing the crime, if known.
