



Title: Community Cat Volunteer

Profile: Our community cat volunteers help care for the cats who are temporarily in our care for our TNR (Trap-Neuter-Return) program.

As a Community Cat Volunteer, you will:

- Clean and disinfect pet carriers and humane traps.
- Refresh newspaper for cats pre/post-surgery.
- Feed cats post-surgery.

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Must be able to stand and kneel continuously for two hours.

Required Training:

- New volunteer orientation.
- Train with current community cat volunteer on first night.

Schedule:

- Commit to two hours per week on the same day.
- Monday through Thursday
- Morning shift – 8a.m.-10a.m.
- Afternoon shift – 3p.m.-5p.m.

Dress Code: Volunteers are expected to wear sensible attire while volunteering. This includes closed-toed shoes; such as tennis shoes, and clothing that can be easily laundered.
