\*TNR, or trap-neuter-return, is the most humane method of controlling feral and free roaming cat populations. For additional medical assistance the following prices may apply.

## Other Veterinary Services

### Community Cat Level I

- Mild upper respiratory infection (sneezing, nasal discharge, congestion)
- Bite wound infection (one wound, small)
- Flea allergy skin infection (hair loss on rump, itchy)
- Ear mites or ear infection (ear wax, itchy)

**\$45** Includes examination and 1-2 medications

### Community Cat Level II

- Moderate upper respiratory infection (lots of nasal discharge, congestion)
- Bite wound infection (medium sized, deep or multiple)
- Flea allergy skin infection (lots of hair-loss, scabbing and itchy)
- Ear mites or ear infection (lots of ear wax, swollen ears, very itchy)

**\$90** Includes examination, 2-4 medications, injections, and overnight stay

### Community Cat Level III

- Severe upper respiratory infection (labored breathing, severe nasal and eye discharge)
- Emergency eye removal
- Leg amputation
- Skin disease (bald, lots of redness, lots of scabbing)
- Trauma or injury (hit by car, dog attack)

**\$140** Includes examination, 4 or more medications, IV fluids, bloodwork, hospitalization, and any surgery required
